GOVERNANCE

- The MOST™ program's successful outcomes were presented at the American Association on Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities' and Applied Behavior Analysis International's Autism Conferences.

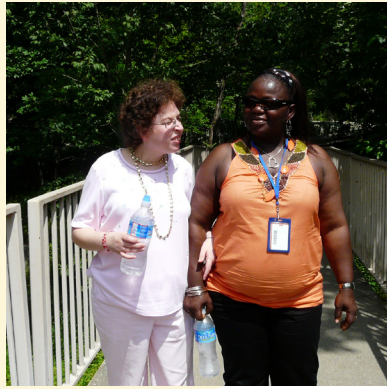
The dedication ceremony was part of the second Transition Celebration recognizing the accomplishments of six MOST™ participants who have begun their new employment and/or vocational programs.

Meaningful Opportunities for Successful Transitions (MOST™) is a one year individualized program of activities and training designed to facilitate successful transitions into the adult community for individuals with disabilities. The MOST™ program serves as a portal for individuals and their families through which they are introduced and integrated into a broad range of community resources. MOST™ focuses on facilitating outcomes for participants in three domains: Self-Sufficiency (including self-help, independent living, and safety skills), Community (including social skills, transportation, and recreation), Vocation (including employment, education, vocational training, and day habilitation.)



CSLA Expands Services in Northern Virginia

In accordance with the 2008 Strategic Plan we are expanding services in Northern Virginia In Home Support Services are part of JFGH's Henry and Alice Greenwald Community Supported Living Arrangement (CSLA) program. The CSLA program provides the same level of involvement and services as the Group Home program but allows the individual to have the services delivered to his or her own home.

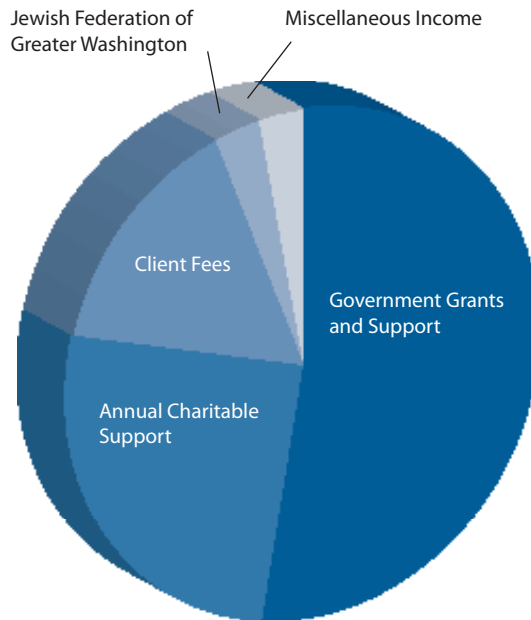

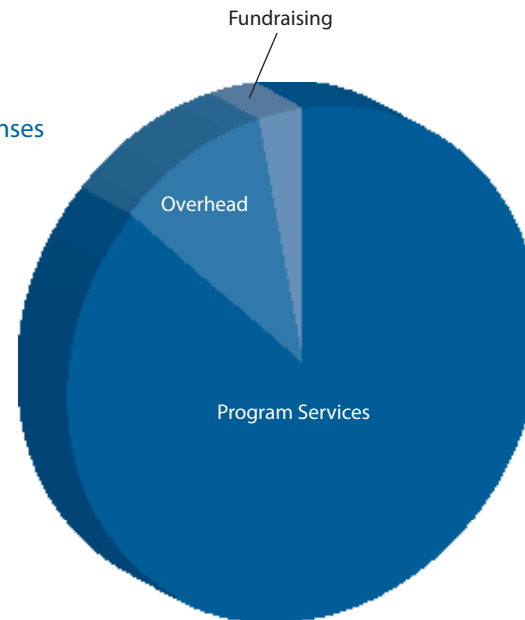
